"The workshop helped me to understand the world a little better."

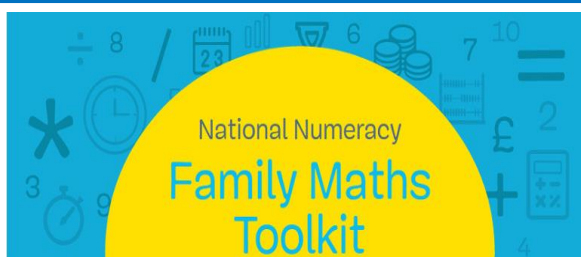


Coffee Mornings
