"I get to ride my favourite pony every week." - **Maya 5R**



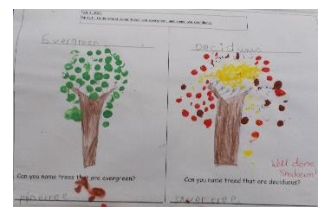
Year 1 Work

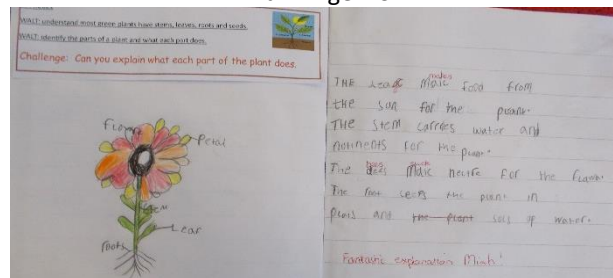
